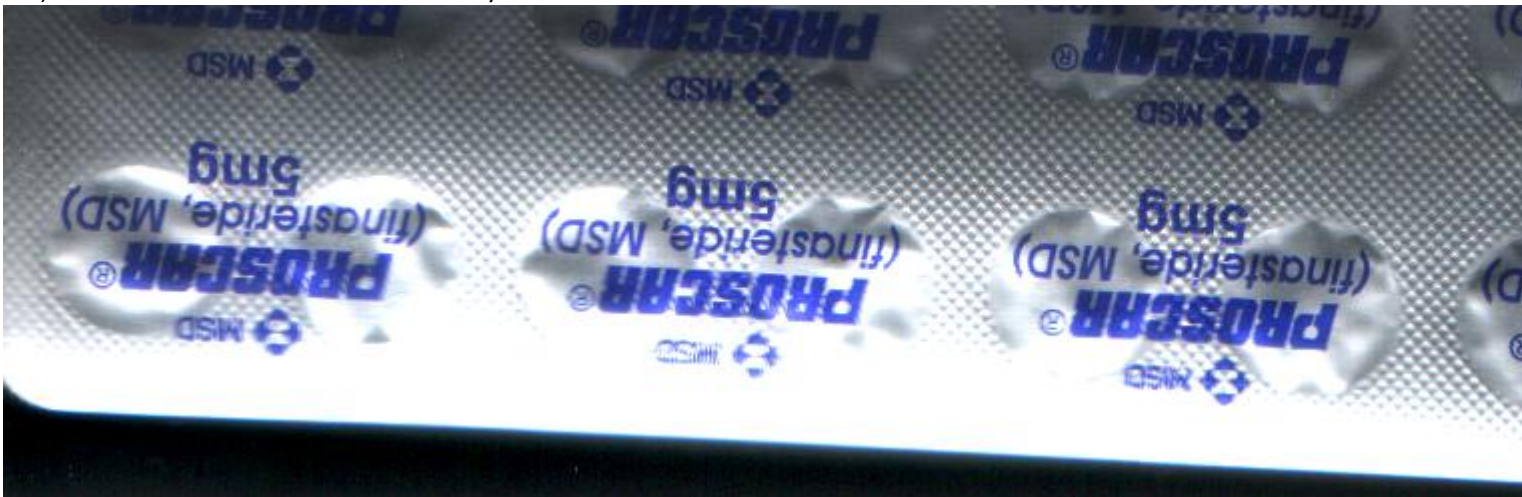
Eingepackt waren lediglich zwei Blister mit jeweils 15 Tabletten und ein Beipackzettel, siehe Bilder.

INFORMATION FOR THE

Please read this leaflet carefully before you start to take PROSCAR on prescription. Some of the information in the previous leaflet may not apply to you.

Remember that this medicine is only for you. Only a doctor should decide if you should take it.

What is PROSCAR®?

PROSCAR (finasteride, MSD) is a film-coated tablet. It contains 5 mg of finasteride as the active ingredient.

In addition, PROSCAR contains the following inactive ingredients: lactose, pregelatinized starch, sodium starch glycollate and microcrystalline cellulose.

PROSCAR is available as 5 mg tablets with [MSD 72] on one side and [Proscar] on the other. It is supplied in packs of 30 tablets.

PROSCAR is a 5-alpha reductase inhibitor. It shrinks the enlarged prostate gland.

Why has my doctor prescribed PROSCAR?

Your doctor has prescribed PROSCAR because you have a condition known as benign prostatic hyperplasia or BPH. Your prostate gland, which is near your bladder, has become bigger and is making it more difficult for you to pass water.

PROSCAR shrinks the enlarged prostate and relieves urinary symptoms. PROSCAR will reduce the need for surgery resulting from these conditions.

What is the prostate?

The prostate is a walnut-sized gland found only in men. It is located below the bladder and it surrounds the urethra, a tube that carries

What should I know about PROSCAR?

Who should not take PROSCAR?

Do not take PROSCAR if you are allergic to any of its ingredients.

The condition for which PROSCAR is prescribed occurs only in men. Women should not take PROSCAR.

What should I tell my doctor about taking PROSCAR?

Tell your doctor about all the medicines you have or have had, and all the other medicines you are taking.

What should I know about BPH and PROSCAR?

BPH develops over a long period of time. Many patients show early improvement with PROSCAR. You may need to take PROSCAR for several months to see if it improves your symptoms. You must visit your doctor regularly for monitoring and evaluation of your condition.

While BPH is not cancer, BPH and prostate cancer are the two conditions that can cause urinary symptoms. A doctor can evaluate your symptoms and check for possible causes.

PROSCAR can affect a blood test called PSA. You should have a PSA test done, to see if you have prostate cancer, before taking PROSCAR.
